
## **Crimes Committed During Domestic Violence**

Figure 4 shows that for both IPV and DV against children the most common offense committed was simple assault (3,514 / 59.83% and 399 / 52.85% respectively) followed by aggravated assault (1,481 / 25.22% and 120 / 15.89%).

Then for IPV, the next most common offenses were kidnapping/abduction (358 / 6.10%), intimidation (277 / 4.72%), rape (179 / 3.05%), and other (57 / 0.97%).<sup>1</sup> For DV against children 18 under, the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> most common offenses are comprised of fondling (76 / 10.07%), rape (58 / 7.68%), and intimidation (42 / 5.56%). Figure 4 illustrates this information and more.
