

Crimes Committed During Domestic Violence

Figure 4 shows that for both IPV and DV against children the most common offense committed was simple assault (3,514 / 59.83% and 399 / 52.85% respectively) followed by aggravated assault (1,481 / 25.22% and 120 / 15.89%).

Then for IPV, the next most

common offenses were

kidnapping/abduction (358 /

6.10%), intimidation (277 / 4.72%),

rape (179 / 3.05%), and other (57 /

0.97%).¹ For DV against children 18

under, the 3rd, 4th, and 5th most

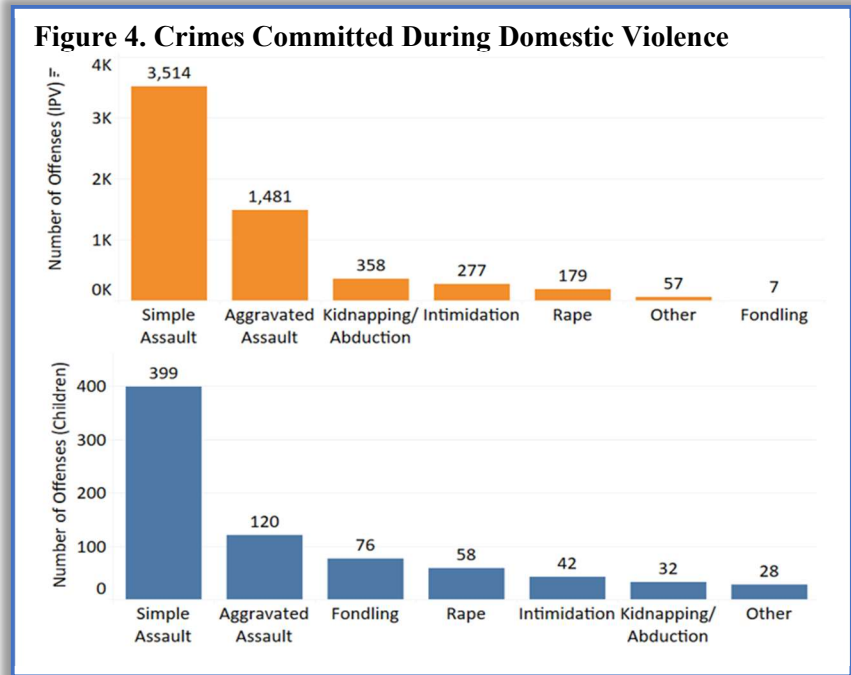
common offenses are comprised of

fondling (76 / 10.07%), rape (58 /

7.68%), and intimidation (42 /

5.56%). Figure 4 illustrates this

information and more.



¹ Seven offenses –murder/non-negligent manslaughter, statutory rape, sodomy, incest, negligent manslaughter, sex trafficking, and sexual assault with an object – are represented in the “other” category.
