In most incidents, sex trafficking was the only offense recorded; however, four incidents included multiple offenses. Table 1 shows these four incidents and the number of different offenses associated with each. There appears to be few similarities concerning the types of offenses committed in conjunction with sex trafficking; however, more data is needed to detect trends. Continued review of these NIBRS data may reveal patterns. The data were also analyzed for common drugs suspected of being used

during sex trafficking incidents. Analysis revealed that in 2016 one incident (“Incident #1” depicted on Table 1 above) involved crack cocaine and “other narcotic(s).”
